- The Principal read her report to the BOM.
- The BOM would like to thank Saoirse McGarrigle for her work on the BOM. Saoirse will be stepping down from the BOM. A new female community nominee will now be sought.
- Our Bake/Craft Sale raised €1400 in total. Thanks to Selina for co-ordinating, student's council, parent volunteers, teachers and customers.
- Voluntary Contribution total is now at €3460. Thank you to all who has contributed, money goes to the day to day running costs of the school.
- Our recent Sponsored Walk raised a total of €2405 (including sale of soup). Thanks to Maria, Alan and all out parent volunteers.
- The school has now raised a total of €8193 in fundraising in term 1. The BOM recognises the hard work of all the school community in raising this amount.
